The fellowship is for \$5000.

- The fellowship is open to all financial members of the NSW Secondary Deputy Principals Association Inc
- The fellowship will be awarded for a research project proposal with the best potential to create improved policy and practice to advantage public education.

Applicants need to briefly outline the nature and purpose of their proposed research and demonstrate:

- A commitment to public education
- An understanding of the issues and policies which impact on public education and the work of Deputy Principals
- Ability in research, writing and development of recommendations
- A demonstrated capacity to disseminate results of research to other Deputy Principals
- That their research can improve policy and practice to advantage public education and the work of Deputy Principals
- An articulated beneficial outcome of the proposed research.

The recipient of the Fellowship will be expected to present a final report to the Term 3 meeting of the State Congress of the Association and present a session at the 2009 Annual

- The report will become the property of the NSWSDPA.
- The report will be published, in whole or in part, on the Associations website after that Conference.
- Applicants should provide two referees
- Applications will remain confidential
