

Proposed change to the Constitution

The State Congress supports the proposed amendment to the Constitution at the 2009 Annual General Meeting:

Current:

6.3.1 The Executive of the Association shall comprise the following elected members:

- President;
- Vice President;
- Honorary Treasurer;
- Honorary Secretary.

Proposed change:

6.3.1 The Executive of the Association shall comprise the following elected members:

- President;
- 2 Vice Presidents;
- Honorary Treasurer;
- Honorary Secretary.

Explanation:

This change recognises the expanded role of the Association in addressing the professional learning needs of secondary deputy principals. At present, the single vice president is working tirelessly to support the welfare of deputies and the professional learning is being strongly led by a member of the State Congress. This change recognises the equal importance of both sets of needs in the workings of the Association and would allow a vice president to lead each key area.

If the constitution is so amended, then the position of the second vice president becomes available for election at the 2010 Annual General Meeting.
